Purpose of the Position:

To provide pastoral leadership, care and shepherding to EFCL's Mandarin Congregation.

Responsibilities

1. Mandarin Language Ministry Leadership

- Plan, organize, and lead Mandarin-language worship services, Bible studies, and prayer meetings.
- Preach and teach Scripture in a culturally relevant and theologically sound manner in alignment with the EFCC Statement of Faith.
- Provide spiritual guidance and pastoral care to individuals and families in the Mandarin-speaking congregation.

2. Community Outreach and Connection

- Build relationships with the local Mandarin-speaking community to identify spiritual and practical needs.
- Develop and implement outreach initiatives to engage and welcome new individuals into the church community.

- Represent EFCL within the Mandarin-speaking community to foster trust, collaboration, and mutual understanding.

3. Program Coordination

- Work with church leadership to align Mandarin programming with EFCL's overall vision and mission.
- Coordinate ministry events such as discipleship training, small groups, and fellowship gatherings in Mandarin.
- Recruit, equip, and mentor volunteers to serve effectively within the Mandarin ministry.

4. Collaboration and Communication

- Collaborate with other ministry leaders to integrate Mandarin ministry into the broader life of the church.
- Report regularly to the pastoral team on the progress, challenges, and opportunities within the Mandarin ministry.
- Foster unity and cooperation between the Mandarin-speaking congregation and other language groups within the church.
