Peoples Church was planted on May 16,1953 with a congregation of 13 disciples, and joined the Associated Gospel Churches (AGC) within the year. Our first worship building was on Plowing Match Road and there we grew in number and converts to Christ, reaching out to the community and also establishing our missions committee. After much growth the Lord provided our present location and the first building in 1966. The years since then have seen a number of building expansions and lot enlargements along the way as the Lord prospered the ministry of His church here.

God has given us a rich diversity of people who are united in our determination to give God glory together and who are determined through the Spirit and Word, to make a difference for the Kingdom of God.

We are relational in nature—as born-again believers in Christ, God has given us a spirit of fellowship and warmth, which is sincere and honest.
