Responsibilities

- Supervise youth and guide them around camp in accordance with their daily schedule.
- Support instructors during hands-on activities and assist in behavior management.
- Oversee and manage cabin cleanliness, conduct a daily cabin inspection, and report any repairs that need to be made to the Maintenance Director.
- Contribute to and work during evening programs.
- Lead group recreational activities during cabin time and as needed
- Help with housekeeping responsibilities in preparation for upcoming camp week.
- Instruct and lead assigned skill.

Requirements

- Maintain a close, intimate relationship with God as a devoted follower of Jesus Christ.
- Be an active participant in the life of a local church.
- Affirm and support our organization's Community Covenant and Statement of Faith, and be committed to YFC's mission.
- Embrace YFC's core values with a strong heart for evangelism.
- Able to live and work in a camp environment during part of the year while being flexible and patient in nature.
- Experience working with youth in a supervisory capacity would be an asset.
- Take initiative, pay close attention to details, and be willing to adapt.
- Able to work well in a team as well as on your own.
