Note 1: All students in Practicum 2 participate in the online component and in the face to face module in January. Students should be advised that, due to the exigencies of the delivery model we follow for Practicum 2, students are required to participate in the full week of the module component.

Note 2: Students are also required to participate in non-graded individual therapy, at their expense, with a department-approved outside counsellor of their choice.

Note 3: BI5102 must be taken prior to, or concurrently with, the first OT or NT Bible course. (Available to Distance students less frequently, it must be taken prior to, or concurrent with, the second OT or NT Bible course.) This does not apply to MA (Theological Studies) students.

Note 4: BI7107, OT5320, and NT5320 are offered simultaneously as a combined course, and students may select which version to take, each with different syllabi and assignments.

Note 5: The total cost for CP5501 is \$2,400, which includes tuition and all additional fees (not including the individual therapy in Note 2 or room and board). For international students, this amount will increase by the regular difference between international and domestic tuition.
