- Applicant must meet criteria for enrollment.
- Applicant must be enrolled in a University College or Seminary degree program.
- Applicant must maintain an acceptable Accumulated Grade Point Average (AGPA) of 2.0.
- Applicant must be enrolled in at least 3 credits per semester.
