OUR STORY

Grace Baptist Church began on February 15, 1987, when Weldrick Road Baptist and Liberty Baptist merged to form a new fellowship. Weldrick Road had been established in the 1950s but had dwindled in numbers and was struggling to carry on. Liberty was a three-year-old church plant under the leadership of Doug Sargeant with 65 people meeting in a school in Thornhill. Together these congregations possessed vision, momentum, and a building in a strategic part of a growing community.

Over the years, Grace has impacted the community through a food delivery service for the poor, a deaf ministry which grew into a deaf church, a preschool, and its own soccer league. Today, it hosts an ESL ministry, an outreach to seniors, and most recently a Winter Fest drawing hundreds from the community. Our ministries to children, youth, and young adults impact the next generation. And more than anything, Grace has been a place where the gospel has been proclaimed and God's Word has changed lives.

And that commitment extends across Canada and around the world as we dedicate 20% of our budget to missionary partnerships with church planters, Indigenous missionaries, and ministers to the urban poor in Canada as well as church planters in Japan, the Middle East, Romania, Russia and Ukraine.













OUR COMMUNITY

The City of Richmond Hill is located in York Region and is home to more than 200,000 residents. It is rated as one of the six best places to live and work in Canada and is the only GTA community to make it into the top ranking.

According to the Conference Board of Canada, "Richmond Hill has strong results in education, innovation and society. It is the third-most diverse city in Canada and boasts the highest number of graduates in engineering, science and math per capita."

The city's three largest ethnicities are Chinese, Iranian, and Russian, and the church is situated across the street from the largest Jewish community centre outside of Israel. We are positioned to reach the world.

We are a church that believes the normative Christian disciple is one of increasing growth into the image of Christ as seen in the way we daily live our lives.


We are a church that has been strategically placed in close proximity to Toronto and we have a desire to reach our neighbors, the nations, and the next generation.

- Develop a process for ministry effectiveness evaluation.
- Participate in our weekly worship services.
- Have an opportunity to preach throughout the year as needed.
