Note 2: Students are also required to participate in 6 sessions of non-graded individual therapy, at their expense, with a department-approved outside counsellor of their choice.

Note 3: BI5102 must be taken prior to, or concurrently with, the first OT or NT Bible course. (Available to Distance students less frequently, it must be taken prior to, or concurrent with, the second OT or NT Bible course.) This does not apply to MA (Theological Studies) students.

Note 6: Practicum 3 & 4 students will be required to secure their own internship placement and clinical supervision. Depending on the internship arrangement, students may be required to pay directly for clinical supervision. Supervision rates will vary based on the province and supervisor.
