Bridge Drop-In Team Member

The Bridge Drop-In Team Member's primary responsibility is to develop and maintain strong mentoring relationships with local neighbourhood children and youth through the running and coordinating of Inner City Youth Alive (ICYA) outreach ministries. ICYA is a faith based, non-profit organization working in Winnipeg's North End.

This position is 40-hours per week and the team member reports to the Bridge Drop-in Director.

Primary Role:

- Make a positive impact on North End children and youth through The Bridge Drop-In ministry. An emphasis will be placed on building strong mentoring relationships for the purpose of evangelism and discipleship of local children and youth.
- Act as a point of contact for new children and youth who move into the community.
- Participate in Bridge Drop-In two or three evenings per week including:
 - Helping plan Bible lessons, crafts and group activities on a weekly basis.
 - Helping run the Drop-In in a manner where children and youth feel safe and cared for and they are learning basic lessons and truths from the Bible.
 - Creating opportunities for volunteers and staff to make meaningful connections with the kids attending Drop-In.
- Help development and implement an evangelistic driven program for local children during the summer months, including recruiting children and running a Daily Vacation Bible School program.
- Help plan community events for local kids and their families including the annual community BBQ and Christmas party.
- Work with other team members in sharing resources, wisdom and experience to benefit the overall Bridge Drop-In ministry.

Personal:

- To operate within the Lifestyle and Morality Standards of ICYA.
- To maintain a vibrant spiritual life and to seek to grow in his/her personal relationship with Jesus Christ through reading scripture, praying, and personal discipleship.
- To allow time for spiritual disciplines in his/her life. Quarterly retreats are encouraged for the purpose of prayer, fasting, and quiet reflection. A personal mentor or accountability group is recommended to support him/her in their ministry.
- To seek out training opportunities that will better equip him/her for ministry.

Accountability:

- Regular meetings with ICYA's Bridge Director for the purpose of evaluation, supervision, and prayer.
