### Gem Lake Wilderness Camp

Gem Lake Wilderness Camp is one of the ministries of Inner City Youth Alive. The camp is located on an island in Nopiming Provincial Park. During July and August we bring 12-15 campers out each week to enjoy Gods creation, build relationship and grow together on our faith journey. Our campers range in age from 10-18 years old and most attend programs at our drop-in center in the North End of Winnipeg.

City-Camp Liaison:

The City-Camp Liaison works primarily out of the Inner City Youth Alive office in Winnipeg. It is a supportive role for the Gem Lake Wilderness Camp staff. The position is approximately 2/3 time and runs primarily in July and August. If available, the Liaison person could also help with camper signup in June as well. Responsibilities include driving campers to and from camp, shopping and packing up food and supplies for the wilderness camp program and contacting/reminding campers of upcoming camp dates. A class 4 driver's license is required (we can help with that). Applicant needs to be a confident driver, organized, self-motivated and able to work independently but as part of a team. Our Camp-City Liaison can expect to earn around \$5-7,000 for the summer (depending on availability to work in June).
