Local News Media are occasionally invited to Providence to take photos, videos, or obtain comments from students and staff/faculty. In such instances, this is done for the purpose of celebrating student achievement, showcasing learning experiences, or to promote Providence within our communities. Media outlets that regularly feature Providence include, but are not limited to: SteinbachOnline.com, The Carillon Newspaper, and local radio stations.

Providence may publish identifying pictures, video, audio, or text of/about a Providence student, and may include their name, course information, and extracurricular activities.

News Media may publish pictures, video, audio, or text of/about a Providence student, and may include their name, course information, and extracurricular activities.

Providence has limited, or no control, over photographs and videos taken by news media and others in public locations, or at school sanctioned events/activities open to the public - such as sporting events, performances, and concerts. When members of the public are invited/permitted to attend an event, those in attendance may choose to take student photographs, videos, and/or publish identifying information without requesting consent. In such instances, Providence cannot enforce or protect stated permissions.

Information that is released and/or published by news media may be accessible world-wide. Materials created by media may continue to be accessed online, or in other forms, for an indefinite period of time thereafter.
